

CITY COUNCIL MINUTES CITY OF MAYFIELD, KENTUCKY

January 11, 2021

The City Council of the City of Mayfield, Kentucky, met in a meeting on Monday, January 11, 2021 at 5:00 p.m. at city hall. There were present Mayor Kathy S O’Nan, Fire Chief, Ambulance Director & Community Development Coordinator, Jeremy Creason, Police Chief Nathan Kent, Public Works Director Russ Brower, City Attorney Bo Neely, and City Clerk Tamie Johnson.

Police Chief, Nathan Kent, opened the city council meeting.

Councilmember Chuck Whitnell led the council in prayer.

Councilmember Barry McDonald led the council in the pledge to the American flag.

Mayor O’Nan gave a statement to the citizens and councilmembers about plans she would like to see implemented in 2021.

On a motion by Herndon, seconded by Adams and with Carr, Adams, Rodgers, Jackson, Whitnell, McDonald, Todd, Herndon and Johnny Lee Jackson voting yea, and with none voting nay, Council approved the minutes of the December 14, 2020 meeting. Motion passed unanimously.

OLD BUSINESS

On a motion made by McDonald, seconded by Rodgers, and with Carr, Adams, Rodgers, Jackson, Whitnell McDonald, Todd, and Herndon voting yea and with Johnny Lee Jackson voting nay, Council approved on second reading **Fiscal Ordinance 3-20**, a fiscal ordinance amending Fiscal Ordinance 2-20 “an ordinance adopting the annual budget and scheduled salaries for the City of Mayfield, Kentucky, for the fiscal year July 1, 2020 through June 32, 2021 estimating revenues and resources and appropriating funds for the operation of city government.” Motion passed eight to one.

On a motion made by Herndon, seconded by Johnny Lee Jackson, and with Johnny Lee Jackson, Herndon, Todd, McDonald, Whitnell, Jackson, Rodgers, Adams, and Carr voting yea and with none voting nay, Council approved **Resolution 1-1-21**, a resolution accepting the proposal of Spectrum Mid-America, LLC for a non-exclusive ten (10) franchise for the operation of a cable television system within the confines of the City of Mayfield, Kentucky. Motion passed unanimously.

Monthly reports were given by department heads and councilmembers.

With no further business to come before the Council, the meeting was adjourned at 6:00 p.m.
