

CITY COUNCIL MINUTES CITY OF MAYFIELD, KENTUCKY

June 8, 2020

The City Council of the City of Mayfield, Kentucky, met in a meeting on Monday, June 8, 2020 at 6:00 p.m. from City Hall, and various locations in Mayfield, Kentucky. There were present Mayor Kathy S O’Nan, Fire Chief, Ambulance Director & Community Development Coordinator, Jeremy Creason, Police Chief Nathan Kent, Public Works Director Russ Brower, City Attorney Bo Neely, and City Clerk Tamie Johnson.

Police Chief, Nathan Kent, opened the city council meeting.

Councilmember Derrick Parrott read a statement before he led the council in prayer.

Councilmember Carol Todd lead the council in the pledge to the American flag.

Mayor Kathy O’Nan also read a statement before opening the meeting.

Bruce Dobyns, 814 S 3rd St, Mayfield KY, with the Mayfield Graves County NAACP addressed the council.

On a motion by Adams, seconded by Jackson and with Herndon, Parrott, Cox, Myers, Whitnell, McDonald, Jackson, Todd, Adams and Rodgers voting yea, and with none voting nay, Council approved the minutes of the May 11, 2020 meeting. Motion passed unanimously.

OLD BUSINESS

On a motion made by McDonald, seconded by Adams, with Herndon, Parrott, Cox, Myers, Whitnell, McDonald, Jackson, Adams and Todd voting yea and with Rodgers voting nay, Council approved on second reading **Fiscal Ordinance 2-20**, “an ordinance adopting the annual budget and scheduled salaries for the City of Mayfield, Kentucky for the fiscal year July 1, 2020 through June 30, 2021 estimating revenues and resources and appropriating funds for the operation of city government.” Motion passed nine to one.

On a motion made by Rodgers, seconded by Adams, with Rodgers, Todd, Adams, Jackson, McDonald, Whitnell, Myers, Cox, Parrott and Herndon voting yea and with none voting nay, Council approved on second reading **Ordinance 2-20**, “an ordinance of the City of Mayfield, amendment to section VII (I) of Ordinance No 3-19 an ordinance amending the sewer use ordinance (Ordinance 1-19). Motion passed unanimously.

Monthly reports were given by department heads and councilmembers.

With no further business to come before the Council, the meeting was adjourned at 6:51 p.m.
