The City Council of the City of Mayfield, Kentucky, met on Monday, July 8, 2019 at 6:00 p.m. at City Hall, Mayfield, Kentucky. There were present Mayor Kathy S O'Nan, Fire Chief, Ambulance Director & Community Development Coordinator Jeremy Creason, Police Chief Nathan Kent, Public Works Director Russ Brower, City Attorney Dennis Null, and City Clerk Tamie Johnson.
