

CITY COUNCIL MINUTES CITY OF MAYFIELD, KENTUCKY

July 26, 2022

The City Council of the City of Mayfield, Kentucky, met in a special called meeting on July 26, 2022, at 5:00 p.m. at the Purchase Area Development District. There were present Mayor Kathy O’Nan, Police Major Wes Kimbler, Public Works Director Russ Brower, Attorney Bo Neely, and Assistant City Clerk Karen Wilson.

Police Major, Wes Kimbler, opened the city council meeting.

Councilmember Lauren Carr led the council in prayer.

Councilmember Jana Adams led the council in the pledge to the American flag.

Mayor Kathy O’Nan and Sarah Stewart from ClearView Healthcare presented certificates of recognition to employees that were working at the nursing home facility that was hit by the tornado. A special award was presented to Jennifer Rodgers.

Mayor Kathy O’Nan gave the council and public an update on the tornado relief funds and talked about the release of an audit that was performed on the donations the city received.

NEW BUSINESS

On a motion by Adams, seconded by Rodgers, with Carr, Adams, Rodgers, Jackson, Whitnell, McDonald, Parrott, Todd, Herndon and Johnny Lee Jackson voting yea and with none voting nay, Council approved on first reading **Ordinance 5-22**, “an ordinance re-zoning the vacant lot on the 1000 block of Commonwealth Drive (Parcel #106.00.00.056.02) from B-1 Highway Commercial to R-2 Multi-Family.” Motion passed unanimously.

City Attorney, Bo Neely, discussed Resolution 7-1-22 and answered questions from the council concerning this resolution.

On a motion by Johnny Lee Jackson, seconded by Rodgers, with Herndon, Todd, Parrott, McDonald, Whitnell, Jackson, Rodgers, Adams, and Carr voting yea, and with Johnny Lee Jackson abstaining, Council approved **Resolution 7-1-22** “a resolution to amend **Resolution 6-2-22** and **Executive Order 15-22** to address the needs of the Anderson Family, and further amend the **Resolution 6-2-22** and **Executive Order 15-22** to give consideration to commercial lot owners that made application for building permit directly to the State of Kentucky prior to 6-2-22 and 15-22 being passed as these lot owner have made significant financial expenditures in making such an application including, but not limited to survey work, or in some instances, the services of an architect.” Motion passed unanimously.

Councilmember Whitnell left the meeting at 6:13p.m.

City Attorney, Bo Neely, addressed the council concerning the formation of a Mayfield Industrial Board.

Public Works Superintendent Russ Brower gave an update on the City’s paving project for this year.

There was a general discussion concerning tornado recovery, debris, and the timeline for debris removal.

With no further business to come before the Council, the meeting was adjourned at 6:20 p.m.
