The City Council of the City of Mayfield, Kentucky, met in a special called session on Monday, October 23, 2017 at 6:00 p.m. at City Hall, Mayfield, Kentucky. A motion was made by Elder and seconded by Cox to override the Mayor's veto of Ordinance 32-17 "an ordinance of the City of Mayfield amending Ordinance 24-16. Chapter 9, Article III, "Alcoholic Beverages", division five, hours for sale and delivery, section 9-116 to permit holders of quota retail drink licenses to sell alcohol until 1:00 a.m. "

Voting yea – Cox, O'Nan, McDonald, Jackson, Myers, and Elder. Voting nay – Summers, Potts, Whitnell, and Adams.

Motion failed 6 to 4. Vote to overturn veto was required to have seven yeas, one more than majority.

There being no further business to come before the council, meeting was adjourned at 6:20pm.
