May 12, 2014

The City Council of the City of Mayfield, Kentucky, met in regular session on Monday, May 12, 2014 at 6:00 p.m. at City Hall, Mayfield, Kentucky. There were present Mayor Teresa Cantrell, Fire Chief Randy Henson, Police Major Shannon Keller, City Planner Brad Rodgers, Public Works Director Russ Brower, City Attorney Boyd Neely, and City Clerk Tamie Johnson.

On a motion made by Myers, seconded by Stinson, and with Stinson, Myers, Potts, McDonald, O'Nan, Jackson, Page, Adams, and Goodman, council approved the natural gas bid submitted by Atmos Energy. Motion passed unanimously.

Mayor Cantrell recognized Great Ambitions and Power Truss as this month's business leaders. Amanda Morris with Great Ambitions and Neal & Brad Power with Power Truss were presented with certificates of appreciation by Mayor Cantrell.

Council members Charles Whitnell arrived at 6:06

Mayor Cantrell read a proclamation recognizing May as Kentucky Drug Court month. Lori Gilbert and Tina Cavitt were present for the presentation.

Mr. Jack Brueggemann at 1110 Wilton Ave, Mayfield addressed the council concerning the street paving, inspection of the paving and the selection process for paving.

On a motion by Myers, and seconded by Adams and with Stinson, Myers, Potts, McDonald, O'Nan, Whitnell, Jackson, Adams, Page, and Goodman voting yea, and with none voting nay, Council approved the minutes from the April 14, 2014 meeting. Motion passed unanimously.

OLD BUSINESS

On a motion made by McDonald, seconded by Potts, with Stinson, Myers, Potts, McDonald, O'Nan, Whitnell, Jackson, Page, Adams, and Goodman, voting yea and with none voting nay, council approved on second reading, **Fiscal Ordinance 1-14** "an ordinance amending **Fiscal Ordinance 2-13** an ordinance adopting the annual budget and scheduled salaries for the City of Mayfield, Kentucky for the fiscal year July 1, 2013 through June 30, 2014, estimating revenues and resources and appropriating funds for the operation of city government." Motion passed unanimously.

On a motion made by O'Nan, seconded by McDonald, with Goodman, Adams, Page, Jackson, Whitnell, O'Nan, McDonald, Potts, Myers, and Stinson, voting yea and with none voting nay, council approved on second reading **Fiscal Ordinance 2-14**, "an ordinance adopting the annual budget and scheduled salaries for the City of Mayfield, Kentucky for the fiscal year July, 2014 through June 30, 2015 estimating revenues and resources and appropriating funds for the operation of city government." Motion passed unanimously.

NEW BUSINESS

On a motion made by Myers, seconded by McDonald, with Stinson, Myers, Potts, McDonald, O'Nan, Whitnell, Jackson, Page, Adams, and Goodman, voting yea and none voting nay, council approved **Resolution 5-1-14**, "a resolution authorizing Time Warner Cable, to serve as the franchisee for the City of Mayfield KY and to operate and maintain a cable television system within the city limits". Motion passed unanimously.

Reports from Department Heads and Committees were given. Council members also gave their respective board reports.

With no further business to come before the Council, the meeting was adjourned at 6:55 p.m.
