

# CITY COUNCIL MINUTES CITY OF MAYFIELD, KENTUCKY

June 10, 2013

The City Council of the City of Mayfield, Kentucky, met in regular session on Monday, June 10, 2013 at 6:00 p.m. at City Hall, Mayfield, Kentucky. There were present Mayor Teresa Cantrell, Fire Chief Mike Jones, Police Lieutenant Daniel Crofoot, City Planner Brad Rodgers, Public Works Director Russ Brower, City Attorney Boyd Neely, and City Clerk Tamie Johnson.

Council member, Jana Adams, led the council in prayer.

Council member Tyler Goodman, led the pledge to the American flag.

Mayor Cantrell recognized Richie Kemp, Attorney at Law and West Kentucky Rural Electric Cooperative as this month's business and industry leaders. Richie Kemp and David Smart, President and CEO, Ron Mayes, Vice President of Finance and Jamie Sear-Rawlings with West Kentucky Rural Electric Cooperative were presented with certificates of appreciation.

Mayor Cantrell recognized Ryan Drane the new Graves Growth Alliance Executive Director.

Ms. Susan Lee, with Mayfield Graves County Senior Citizens, presented a request for a zero interest loan to the council .

Mr. Joseph Williams, 209 E Sunset Dr, Mayfield Ky 42066, addressed the council concerning the no smoking ordinance.

Mr. Mason Todd, 718 Backusburg Rd, Mayfield Ky 42066, also addressed the council concerning the no smoking ordinance.

On a motion by O'Nan, and seconded by Whitnell and with Stinson, Myers, Potts, McDonald, O'Nan, Whitnell, Jackson, Page, Adams and Goodman voting yea, and with none voting nay, Council approved the minutes from the May 13, 2013 meeting. Motion passed unanimously.

## OLD BUSINESS

On a motion by Myers, and seconded by Potts, and with Stinson, Myers, Potts McDonald, O'Nan, Whitnell. Jackson, Page, Adams, and Goodman voting yea and with none voting nay, council approved on second reading **Fiscal Ordinance 1-13** "an ordinance amending Fiscal Ordinance 2-12 an ordinance adopting the annual budget and scheduled salaries for the City of Mayfield, Kentucky for the fiscal year July 1, 2012 through June 30, 2013 estimating revenues and resources and appropriating funds for the operation of city government.". Motion passed unanimously.

On a motion by McDonald, and seconded by O'Nan, and with Goodman, Adams, Page, Jackson, Whitnell, O'Nan, McDonald, Potts, Myers, and Stinson voting yea and with none voting any, council approved on second reading **Fiscal Ordinance 2-13** "an ordinance adopting the annual budget and scheduled salaries for the City of Mayfield, Kentucky for the fiscal year July 1, 2013 through June 30, 2014 estimating revenues and resources and appropriating funds for the operation of city government". Motion passed unanimously.

On a motion by Jackson, and seconded by Goodman, and with Stinson, Myes, Potts, McDonald, O'Nan, Whitnell, Jackson, Page, Adams and Goodman voting yea and with none voting nay, council approved on second reading **Ordinance 5-13** "an ordinance amending Chapter 9 Article III, alcoholic beverages, by extending the hours of sale for caterers." Motion passed unanimously.

## NEW BUSINESS

On a motion by O'Nan, and seconded by Stinson, and with Page, Whitnell, O'Nan, Potts, Myers and Stinson voting yea and with Goodman, Adams, Jackson and McDonald voting nay, council approved on first reading **Ordinance 6-13** "an ordinance relating to the protection of the public health and welfare by prohibiting the smoking tobacco products in building open to the public." Motion passed six to four.

On a motion by Potts, and seconded by Goodman, and with Stinson, Myers, Potts, McDonald, O'Nan, Whitnell, Jackson, Page, Adams, and Goodman voting yea and with none voting nay, council approved **Resolutions 6-1-13 & 6-2-13** "resolutions establishing a Certified City of Ethic Program with Kentucky League of Cities." Motion passed unanimously.

On a motion by Myers, and seconded by Adams, and with Goodman, Adams, Page, Jackson, Whitnell, O'Nan, McDonald,

Potts, Myers, and Stinson voting yea and with none voting nay, council approved **Resolution 6-3-13** "a resolution allowing the mayor to enter into an agreement with the DLG for energy efficiency and conservation grant/loan with Mayfield Electric and Water. Motion passed unanimously.

On a motion by Phil Myers, and seconded by Al Page, and with Stinson, Myers, Potts, McDonald, O'Nan, Jackson, Page, Adams and Goodman voting yea and none voting nay and with Whitnell abstaining, Council approved the drafting of a resolution giving the Mayfield Graves County Senior Citizens an addition \$15,000 from the 2013-2014 budget. Motion passed. Mr. Whitnell chose to abstain due to his father serving as a director for the organization.

Reports from Department Heads and Committees were given. Council members also gave their respective board reports.

With no further business to come before the Council, the meeting was adjourned at 8:00 p.m.
