

CITY COUNCIL MINUTES CITY OF MAYFIELD, KENTUCKY

December 8, 2014

The City Council of the City of Mayfield, Kentucky, met in regular session on Monday, December 8, 2014 at 6:00 p.m. at City Hall, Mayfield, Kentucky. There were present Mayor Teresa Cantrell, Fire Chief Randy Henson, Police Chief Bryan Morrison, City Planner Brad Rodgers, Public Works Director Russ Brower, City Attorney Boyd Neely, and City Clerk Tamie Johnson.

Council member Jonathan Stinson led the council in prayer.

Council member Al Page led the council in the pledge to the American flag, doing so in memory of the lives lost at Pearl Harbor.

Mayor Cantrell recognized Sheridan Eyecare and K & T Lamp as this month's business leaders. Denise Sheridan and Tonya Batts with Eyecare Associates and James and Cindy Burgess with K & T Lamb were presented with certificates of appreciation by Mayor Cantrell.

Mayor Cantrell recognized council members Jonathan Stinson, Johnny Jackson and Tyler Goodman for their service to the City of Mayfield. They were presented with plaques that stated their years of service.

Mayor Cantrell recognized Hugh and Jill Kirby as the 2014 Spirit of Mayfield recipients. Mr. and Mrs. Kirby have donated many hours with the design and construction of Cartwright Grove.

Brandi Greenfield, 141 Potts Road, Murray KY, with Police Wives of Kentucky, addressed the council and thanked the community for the donations to the Cruiser Care Packages. The packages help the officers throughout the state with needed items that they don't always have time to stop and pickup.

David Wilson, 1710 Williams Lane, Mayfield KY, addressed the council to thank them for the work that was performed at the Mayfield Graves County Little League ballpark by the public works department.

On a motion by Myers, and seconded by Adams and with Stinson, Myers, Potts, McDonald, O'Nan, Whitnell, Jackson, Page, Adams, and Goodman, voting yea, and with none voting nay, Council approved the minutes, from the November 10, 2014 meeting. Motion passed unanimously.

OLD BUSINESS

On a motion by Goodman, and seconded by O'Nan, with Stinson, Myers, Potts, McDonald, O'Nan, Whitnell, Jackson, Page, Adams, and Goodman, voting yea and with none voting nay, Council approved on second reading **Ordinance 7-14**, "an ordinance establishing rules for Bonfires, Rubbish fires, Open burning, etc." Motion passed unanimously.

Council member Jackson left the meeting at 6:25 pm.

On a motion by McDonald, and seconded by Page, with Goodman, Adams, Page, Whitnell, O'Nan, McDonald, Potts, and Stinson, voting yea and Myers voting nay, Council approved on second reading **Ordinance 8-14**, "an ordinance amending Ordinance 9-03, by setting and defining standards for storm water design and conveyance, storm water quality pollution prevention, and providing for standards for erosion control." Motion passed eight to one.

NEW BUSINESS

On a motion by Page, and seconded by Stinson, with Stinson, Myers, Potts, McDonald, O'Nan, Whitnell, Page, Adams and Goodman, voting yea and with none voting nay, Council approved **Resolution 12-1-14** is a resolution showing support along with the Kentucky General Assembly for the LIFT tax which will fund local projects such as parks, roads, arts and cultural attractions, transportation, libraries, recreational and sports facilities. Motion passed unanimously.

Jennifer Beck-Walker provided the council with an update from the Purchase Area Development District.

Cynthia Elder also provided the council with an update from the Mayfield Graves County Tourism Commission.

Reports from Department Heads and Committees were given. Council members also gave their respective board reports.

With no further business to come before the Council, the meeting was adjourned at 7:18 p.m.
